RULES & REGULATIONS

- Each team is required to provide a team name.
- Participants are to prepare their own ingredients to create a sandwich that is relevant to the Safari theme.
- Only Gardenia Super Soft & Fine 100% Enriched Wholemeal bread will be provided and used for the competition.
- The time allocated for making the sandwich is 30 minutes. An additional 5 minutes will be given for tidying the work area.
- Each team should prepare a main portion for presentation and 2 bite sizes for tasting by the judges. (One of the 2 judges will be from Gardenia)

- All utensils, crockery and cutlery are to be provided by the participants.
- Gardenia will provide aprons, caps, disposable gloves and disposable tablecloths to all participants.
- Entries will be judged on the following criteria, a total of 100 points:
 - a) Presentation (30 points)**
 - b) Taste (35 points)**
 - c) Preparation (25 points)**
 - d) Title (10 points)**
- The Judge's decision is final and the Organisers reserved the right to amend the prizes (subject to the same value).
